North Meck Lacrosse Players are financially responsible for their own equipment with the exception of Helmets. (Helmets are checked out by players and returned at the end of the season). Players may purchase their own helmets (royal blue with gray visor) if they wish and North Meck will provide the helmet stickers.

I understand that my son will need to purchase the following equipment on his own.

- attack or midfielder stick (pole + head) – must have own attack pole if playing attack/midfield
- defense stick (pole + head) – must have own defensive pole if playing defense
- shoulder pads
- arm pads
- gloves (must be royal blue)
- rib pads (optional)
- cup
- colored mouthpiece

Refund Policy for North Meck High School Lacrosse Program

As part of the registration process, all North Meck HS lacrosse players and their parents agree to the following **refund** policy: Our **refund** policy is designed to minimize the impact to both parties in the event of a cancellation. Our club program incurs expenses for each participant very early in the registration process including uniforms, common equipment (E.g., helmets and goals), , facility use fees, league dues, first aid equipment, coaches training, etc. Shortly thereafter, the expenses increase again as the program contracts services for officials, coaches, etc. Due to expenses incurred at the time of registration, \$150 of the membership fee is non-refundable (regardless of the reason for cancellation, except when a student may be cut if a tryout period occurs). After March 1 no refunds will be made for any reason. Additionally, no refunds will be paid if there is an injury or if there is academic ineligibility.

In regard to the portion of the dues fee paid to US Lacrosse (\$35 for 2010). This fee, once paid to U.S. Lacrosse, may not be refunded for any reason.
